

Headband



Instructions

Knitting instructions

- Size:** 10cm x 52cm
- Material:** HANSA FARM Baby Alpaca Bulky 50
100% alpaca
color: NFA01 Natur (50 g - corresponds to one bunch)
- Knitting method:** The headband is knitted in a rib pattern.
- Gauge:** Stockinette (knit right sts in row, knit left sts back in row)
With 6.0 mm (size 10) needle: 15M and 20R 0 10 x 10 cm
- Basic pattern:** ribs: knit 1 st right, 1 st left, repeat
Make sure that in each new row a right stitch is knitted over a right stitch and a left stitch over a left stitch.
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- Start:** cast on 16 stitches
- 1st row** Alternate one stitch to the right and one stitch to the left until the end of the row.
- 2nd -104th row** Repeat the 1st row
Then cast off and cut the thread to a length of approx. 10 cm, which is then sewn.
- Finish:** To finish the headband, sew the threads with a needle. To do this, lay the headband halfway to make it circular. Now fold both ends halfway. Weave through with the needle and pull the thread together and knot it. This way you have hidden the ends of the headband in a great loop.
